Time Commitment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One Lord's Day Mass a week, a couple of times per month based on a rotation depending on the number of Extraordinary Ministers
Talents/Skills Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be a practicing Catholic, at least 19 years of age • Must have received the sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist) • Follow the strict guidelines required to bring the Eucharist to the sick (training to be provided) • Keep silent, pray and be reverent while bearing the Eucharist • Be compassionate, respectful and maintain confidence • Have a valid driver's license and/or access to a vehicle • Travel with an unrelated co-Extraordinary Minister (must work in pairs)
